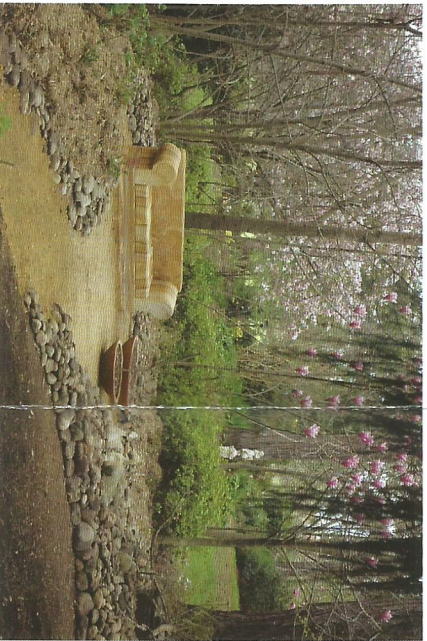
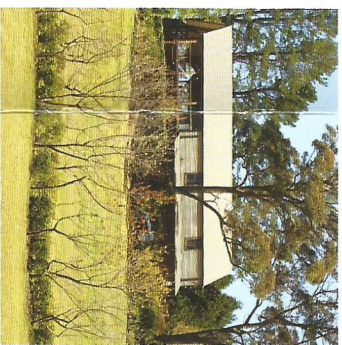


Wildwood is the creation of plant and garden enthusiasts Wayne and Sue Tapping. They began this garden more than 30 years ago and also opened a retail nursery at near by North Richmond. The nursery closed in 2010, allowing the couple to pursue their dream of an open garden with gift shop, nursery and tearoom.

This two hectare garden nestles among 10ha of towering native trees. It is set on a gentle slope with broad, crushed granite paths that meander beside a waterfall and ponds, then wind beneath the trees and across sweeping lawns to a tranquil lake. Seats are scattered throughout to encourage visitors to relax and enjoy the atmosphere.



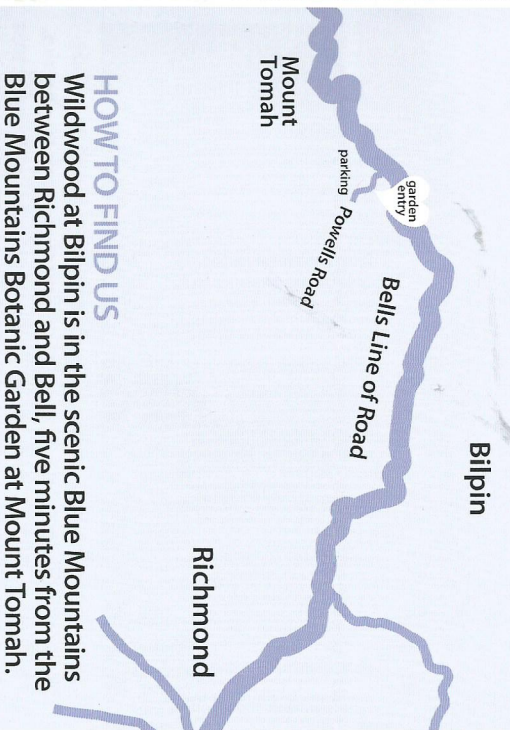
## TEAROOM

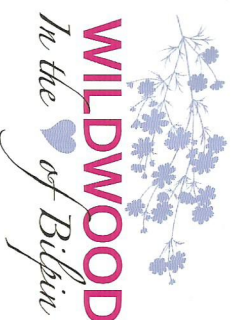

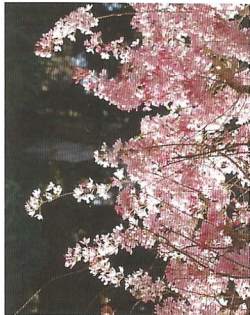

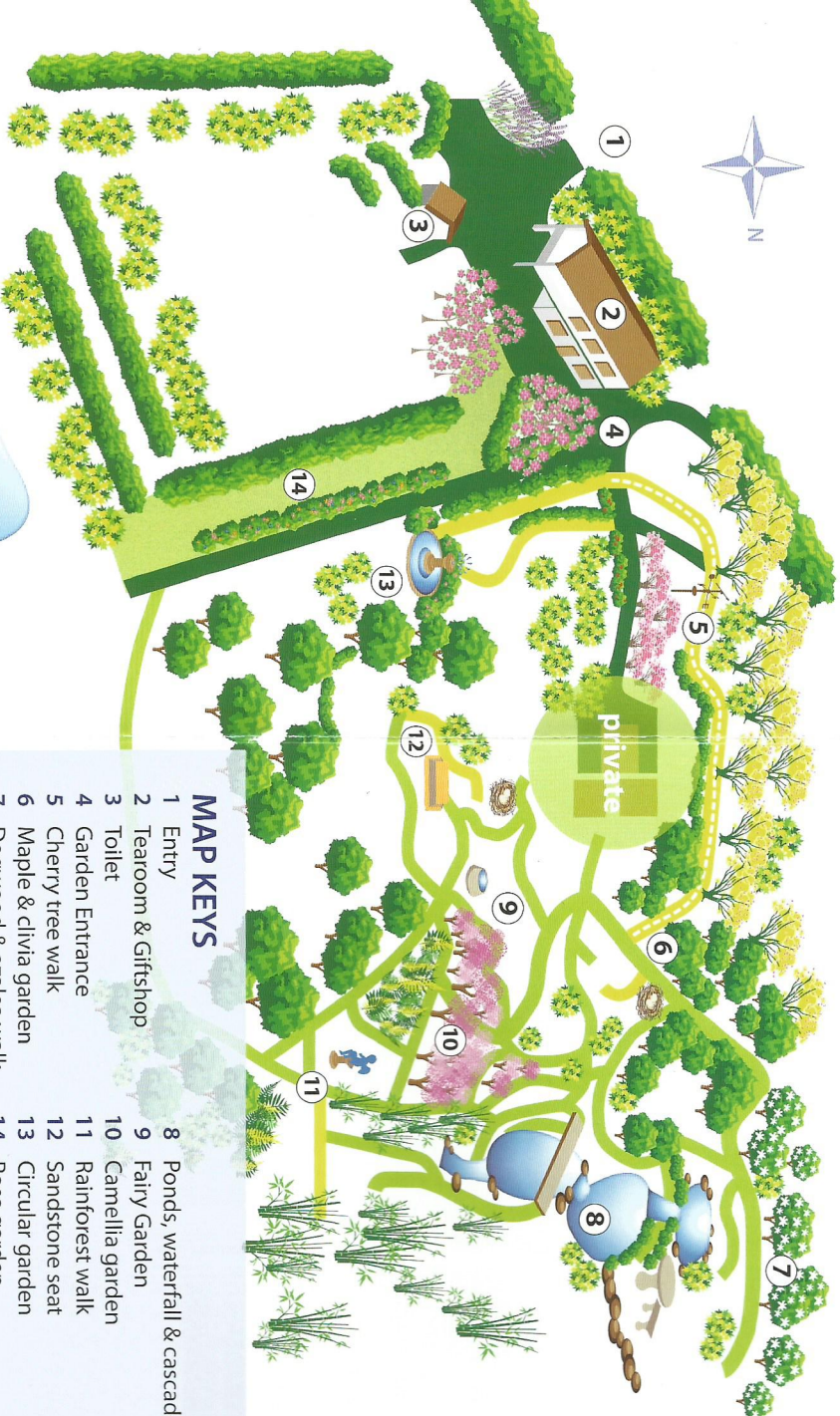

Wildwood celebrates the seasons with a collection of cool climate plants that thrive in the mild climate and deep volcanic soils of this cool mountain region.

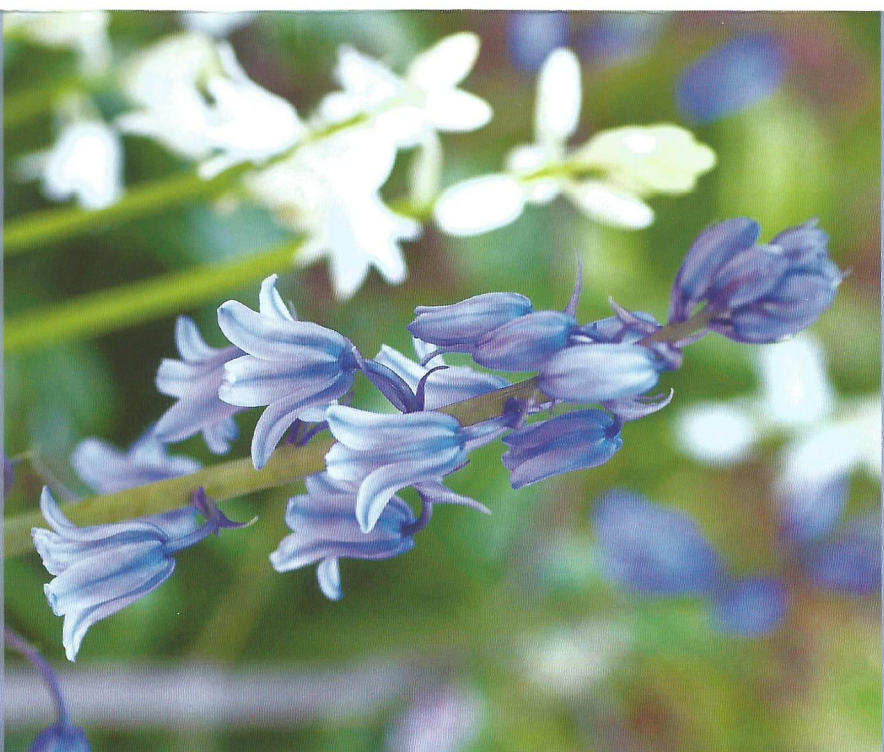
